Special Awards

THE RYAN FAMILY AWARD A special award will be given to a Junior Poultry Exhibitor in honor of all members of the Ryan Family.

AMERICAN POULTRY ASSOCIATION: The APA invites you to become a member. Annual dues are \$15.00 for one (1) year, \$40.00 for three (3) years, \$25.00 for one year outside the U.S. and Canada. Junior dues (for those 18 and under) are \$10.00 per year. Endowment Trust Life Membership is \$240. All Annual and Endowment Trust Life Members receive our yearbook and are eligible to earn points towards a Master Exhibitor Award. Every member is eligible for the awards at this show.

MEDAL AWARDS: Special APA medals and certificates for the following Class Champions and Reserve Class Champions

LARGE CHICKENS: American, Asiatic, English, Mediterranean, Continental, and All Other Standard Breeds.

BANTAMS: Modern Game, Old English Game, Single Comb Clean Legged (Other than Game), Rose Comb Clean Legged, Feather Legged, And All Other Combs Clean Legged.

CERTIFICATE AWARDS: When ten (10) or more are judged, certificates will be given for each of the following: Grand & Reserve Champion Large Chicken, Grand & Reserve Champion Bantam. The above awards will be mailed to winner(s) by APA at a later date. All judging shall be by the latest edition of the American Standard of Perfection, copyrighted by the American Poultry Association, Inc. Application for membership may be made at the show or may be sent to the American Poultry Association, Inc. at the address listed below, but must be prior to the judging to be eligible for the APA awards.

AMERICAN BANTAM ASSOCIATION

PLAQUES will be awarded to Champion and Reserve Champion Bantam. Pins for Champion and Reserve for all seven bantam divisions provided 25 or more birds are competing.

PINS for all starred wins in the show. Only ABA members are eligible to compete for the above awards. Dues are \$15.00 per year — \$40.00 for three years. New members receive a copy of the quarterly and the latest available copy of the Annual American Bantam Association Year Book, which lists many advertisers and includes a complete breed and variety index.

Winners of ABA awards are listed in the year book under Who's Who in Bantams. Starred wins are earned by Champions and Reserve Champions in the seven bantam divisions when the number of birds competing is 100 or more. Starred wins are also awarded to Best and Reserve of breed and Variety when 100 or more birds are competing. A single bird is eligible for only one award and can earn only one starred win.

OPEN POULTRY SHOW SPECIAL RULES

1. This department will be conducted under the rules of the American Poultry Association. Birds will be judged by the comparison method according to the American Standard of Perfection.
2. All birds not claimed by 12:00 noon, SUNDAY, OCTOBER 19, will be removed at the discretion of management.
3. All birds must be brought to the Arkansas State Fair with a numbered leg or wing band (including NPIP flocks) and this band number must be listed on the entry blank.
4. All APA or ABA recognized breeds are eligible to show in this show. If the breed you have is not listed, it should be entered in the "Other" category of its regional origin. If you are unsure which group to enter your animal(s) in, contact either Jerry Wooley at 501-671-2189 or Dr. Keith Bramwell at 479-841-6498
5. **All Open Exhibitors'** must have an Open Signature Form on file in the Livestock Dept.
6. **NEW RULES THIS YEAR:** Exhibitor may enter more than 2 entries per class but will only be paid premiums for their two top placings within that class. **Must use Open Division #'s on your entry form. Do not use the Junior Division or Class numbers on your entry forms.**

SPECIAL PREMIUMS will be paid for the best display by exhibitor and one variety, all breeds and varieties competing. Display awards will be made on the basis of points calculated as follows:

- 1st — 3**
- 2nd — 2**
- 3rd — 1 ½**
- 4th — 1**
- 5th — ½**

Pens double these values.

The points won in each class will be multiplied by the number of entries in that class of the variety. Only the points won in one variety by an exhibitor will be considered in making the display awards.

For the best display, these points will be multiplied by the number of entries in each class, thus awarding valuable prizes to the greatest number of entries. In the case of tie, the exhibitor winning the most points on male birds wins.
