MARKET ANIMAL NOMINATION INFORMATION & PROCEDURES

The 2010 Arkansas State Fair will take place October 8 through the 17th. We hope to see you there! Soon the Market Animal Nomination process will begin and this packet explains all steps necessary to exhibit a Market Animal at the 2010 State Fair. Check the Online Exhibitor Handbook as the Fair date draws near for updates or changes to show information. Market Nominations will be accepted online only. No paper nominations will be accepted. Animal ID Kits may be ordered by returning the order forms included in this packet. The information provided in this packet gives detailed instructions regarding the rules of ASF Market Shows, and the deadlines and procedures required in order to participate in the State Fair Market Animal Program. We look forward to working with all of you to make this process simple and efficient. MARKET NOMINATION GUIDELINES

FFA & 4-H MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS : All contestants in this show must be bona fide Arkansas 4-H Club members enrolled in projects they are exhibiting or FFA Members in the State of Arkansas for the current School year, as certified by their County Agent or Agricultural Education Advisor. Contestants are to be members in good standing and have received an overview of the ASF rules.

AGE REQUIREMENTS : This division is limited to Arkansas students only, who are bona fide members of an Arkansas FFA Chapter or 4-H Club in good standing. Only youth who are at least 9 years of age and have not reached their 20th birthday on or before the first day of the current year Arkansas State Fair (October 8, 2010) are eligible. Additionally, exhibitors may exhibit in this show no later than the fall after graduating from high school or having received a GED certificate or its equivalent, regardless of age.

OWNERSHIP DEADLINE: Is defined as - The date by which the animal(s) must be owned and in the possession and care of the junior exhibitor who will enter and show the animal at the 2010 Arkansas State Fair. "In the possession and care of the junior exhibitor" means that the animal is housed in a location extremely accessible to the junior exhibitor and that the junior exhibitor is the primary caretaker for the animal. Projects are subject to random inspection by any member of the Arkansas State Fair Staff, a Cooperative Extension Agent, or a Vo-Ag Instructor. Violation of this rule will result in immediate disqualification from future State Fair competitive activities and is not subject to protest.

ANIMAL ID KIT: This Kit includes an ASF Ear Tag, a DNA envelope, instructions on how to pull DNA, and a Packing Slip that must be completed when DNA is returned to the State Fair via certified mail – return receipt requested. You will need a pair of needle-nose pliers when pulling DNA. All Market Animals must wear an ASF Ear Tag and have DNA on file with the Livestock Office which is postmarked by the required date. Tags should be in the animal's ear no later than the final date for nomination of that species. **Animal ID Kits must be ordered by Arkansas Extension Agents and Arkansas Vo-Ag Instructors. Exhibitors and 4-H Club Leaders are not allowed to submit orders for Animal ID Kits. The order form is included in this packet. The orders may be sent to the ASF Livestock Office by US Mail (2600 Howard St; Little Rock, AR; 72206) or fax at 501-372-4197. The orders will be filled by ASF Staff and will be mailed (US Mail) to the agent or Ag instructor who placed the order. KITS WILL NOT BE MAILED DIRECTLY TO EXHIBITORS.**

ONLINE NOMINATION: Nominations can only be submitted by an Arkansas Extension Agent or an Arkansas Vo-Ag Instructor who has a valid 2010 username and password issued from the ASF Livestock Office. A new password is required every year, so contact tammy@asfg.net to receive your 2010 password. No phone calls to request passwords please. Nominations are FREE if submitted by appropriate deadlines. Late nominations are available with payment of Late Fees (see Page 1 of this packet for fees and deadlines). Online payment can be made by using a credit card. To nominate Market Animals, visit the ASF Website at www.asfg.net & click on Livestock. A link to the Nomination Site will be provided there.

DNA SUBMITTED TO ASF BY CEA OR VO-AG INSTRUCTOR: Complete DNA samples must be mailed by the CEA or Vo Ag Instructor **CERTIFIED MAIL – RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED:** Mail DNA to: Arkansas State Fair – Livestock Office; 2600 Howard Street; Little Rock, AR 72206. DNA must be postmarked according to the date listed on Page 1 of this packet for each species. **THIS INFORMATION MUST BE MAILED CERTIFIED MAIL – RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED.** We suggest that Exhibitor Signature Forms are included with DNA Samples if they are not already on file with the Livestock Office. DNA Samples **MUST** include hair follicles and each DNA envelope must be sealed (not taped). If the sample is deemed inconclusive by the laboratory because of missing hair follicles, the test will be considered a **MISMATCH** and appropriate penalties will be applied. Individual Animal ID must match **EXACTLY** the ID that was submitted on and inside the DNA Sample Envelope. Any discrepancy or confusion in Animal ID will be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. Questions arising as the result of exhibitor error will be handled on a case by case basis by show officials. Should extra DNA testing be required, and is approved by show officials, to remedy any problem, the cost to the exhibitor will be \$150 per test, payable immediately.

LOST ASF EAR TAGS & SCRAPIE TAGS: Lost ASF Ear Tags can be replaced through Agent or Instructor of record by completing the Lost ID Form at \$25 each. Lost Scrapie Tags are available through Arkansas Livestock & Poultry Commission (required on lambs & goats). ASF Market Lambs & Market Goats MUST possess an ASF Ear Tag AND a Scrapie Tag in order to be allowed on the Fairgrounds. For explanation on Scrapie rules, contact Dr. Pat Badley at Arkansas Livestock & Poultry at 501-907-2400.

EXHIBITOR SIGNATURE FORMS: All Exhibitors at the 2010 ASF must have a current ASF Exhibitor Signature Form on file with the State Fair Livestock Office. This form is available at www.asfg.net. Complete and mail the form to 2600 Howard Street; Little Rock, AR 72206. You may visit the State Fair website for a database of all exhibitors who have a 2010 Exhibitor Signature Form on file. Only one form per calendar year is required for each exhibitor.

STEP BY STEP DIRECTIONS FOR NOMINATING ANIMALS ONLINE WILL BE AVAILABLE ON THE STATE FAIR WEBSITE IN PLENTY OF TIME TO MEET ALL DEADLINES. A NEW USER NAME AND PASSWORD IS REQUIRED FOR VO-AG INSTRUCTORS AND COUNTY EXTENSION AGENTS TO COMPLETE THIS PROCESS. THE USER NAME AND PASSWORD THAT YOU USED IN 2009 WILL NOT WORK. EXHIBITORS CAN NOT NOMINATE ANIMALS ONLINE AND WILL NOT BE GIVEN A USER NAME AND PASSWORD. THE NOMINATION DEADLINES ARE DIFFERENT FROM ANIMAL ID KIT ORDER DEADLINES.

MARKET STEERS
2010 ARKANSAS STATE FAIR
SHOW DATE: TUESDAY, OCTOBER 12, 2010
MINIMUM WEIGHT: 1,000 POUNDS / NO MAXIMUM WEIGHT

Market Steer Ownership Deadline is **May 15, 2010**. Each exhibitor may nominate up to 4 steers and is limited to 2 animals in the show or on the fairgrounds during the Arkansas State Fair. All steers must wear a current ASF ear tag and exhibitor must submit a DNA sample for each steer nominated. Each steer must be nominated online according to the appropriate schedule and fees. Refer to the first page of this packet for details. All questions regarding animal health requirements should be directed to your local veterinarian or Arkansas Livestock & Poultry Commission at 501-907-2400: Attention Dr. Pat Badley, AR State Veterinarian.

All steers must be halter broke and kept under control of the exhibitor while in show ring. Failure to control animal will result in disqualification. No bulls, stags or horned steers may participate. Only steers of beef breeding are eligible. The minimum weight for market steers is 1000 pounds. Show classes will be divided by weight and aligned in show ring by weight from lightest to heaviest in each class. Exhibitors will declare show weights. A 5% weigh-back policy is in place for the Market Steer Show. Any steer is subject to weigh back. All animals may be tested for various drugs and are subject to inspection at any time.

NOMINATE YOUR STEER AT THE SPRING SHOW APRIL 30 - MAY 1
BY FOLLOWING THESE SIMPLE STEPS

- Go to Barn 4 Sales Office with \$27.00 and purchase steer processing forms for State Fair.
- Bring your steer and processing forms to the Equestrian Center during Steer Processing.
- State Fair personnel will pull DNA and put a 2010 ASF ear tag in your steer's ear.
- All records will be verified by the ASF Livestock Office. If confirmed, your steer will be nominated and you will receive a receipt of your nomination via e-mail within the month.

IF YOU DO NOT NOMINATE YOUR STEER AT THE SPRING SHOW...

- Ask your Vo-Ag Instructor or County Extension Agent to order an Animal ID Kit from the State Fair. The form to order this Kit is in this packet or online at www.asfg.net (Livestock). The Kit will cost \$27 if you order by May 10th or \$40 if you order between May 11th and May 17th. No orders will be accepted after May 17th.
- The State Fair will fill the order and return the ID Kit to your CEA or Vo-Ag Instructor. The kit will include an ASF ear tag for your steer, a DNA envelope, instructions on how to pull DNA, and a Packing Slip for returning DNA to the State Fair Livestock Office.
- When you receive the kit: put the tag in your steer's ear and pull DNA from your steer.
- Fill out information on front of DNA Envelope completely and put accurate DNA sample inside envelope and seal the envelope. Make sure the ear tag number matches the DNA you put inside the envelope. Failure to do so will result in a MISMATCHED DNA SAMPLE and your animal could be disqualified.
- Fill out the Packing Slip.
- Put the Packing Slip and a complete DNA Envelope for every steer listed on that Packing Slip in a secure envelope.
- **NO LATER THAN MAY 24TH & ONLY BY USING CERTIFIED MAIL – RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED** mail the envelope to:

From May 24 until June 6th Late Nomination costs \$20.
- AT MIDNIGHT, JUNE 6TH THE DEADLINE WILL PASS AND NO MORE STEERS WILL BE NOMINATED FOR THE 2010 ARKANSAS STATE FAIR.

All rules listed in the 2010 ASF Livestock Premium Book Steer Show section will apply to this show.

MARKET GOATS

2010 ARKANSAS STATE FAIR

SHOW DATE: MONDAY, OCTOBER 11

MINIMUM WEIGHT: 50 / NO MAXIMUM WEIGHT

Market Goat Ownership Deadline is **July 12, 2010**. Each exhibitor may nominate up to 6 goats and is limited to 3 animals in the show or on the fairgrounds. All goats must wear a Scrapie identification ear tag and an ASF Ear Tag. Exhibitor must submit a DNA sample and must be nominated online according to the appropriate schedule and fees. Refer to the first page of this packet for details. All questions regarding animal health requirements should be directed to your local veterinarian or Arkansas Livestock & Poultry Commission at 501-907-2400 – Attention Dr. Pat Badley, AR State Veterinarian.

Either wethers or does may participate. The minimum weight for market goats at the 2010 Arkansas State Fair is 50 pounds, with no maximum. Exhibitors will declare show weights. A 5 pound weigh back policy is in place for the Market Goat Show and any goat is subject to being weighed back. All goats must have baby teeth at the show. **GOATS MAY BE HORNED, BUT MUST BE TIPPED (NO SPECIFIC LENGTH). GOATS DO NOT HAVE TO BE DEHORNED, BUT IS RECOMMENDED.** Show classes will be divided by weight. All animals may be tested for various drugs and are subject to inspection at any time while on the fairgrounds. Animals participating in the dairy breed shows are ineligible for the market show. Market goats meeting percentage requirements may also enter the Boer Goat Show. Separate entry is required. All rules listed in the 2010 ASF Livestock Premium Book Goat Show section will apply to this show.

TO NOMINATE YOUR MARKET GOAT FOR THE STATE FAIR

- Ask your Vo-Ag Instructor or County Extension Agent to order an Animal ID Kit from the State Fair. The form to order this Kit is in this packet or online at www.asfg.net (Livestock). The Kit will cost \$22 if you order by July 5th. If you order between July 6th and July 12th the Kit will cost \$40. No orders will be accepted after July 12th.
- The State Fair will fill the order and return the ID Kit to your CEA or Vo-Ag Instructor. The kit will include an ASF ear tag for your goat, a DNA envelope, instructions on how to pull DNA, and a Packing Slip for returning DNA to the State Fair Livestock Office.
- When you receive your kit: put the tag in your goat's ear and pull DNA from goat.
- Fill out information on front of DNA Envelope completely and put accurate DNA sample inside envelope and seal the envelope. Make sure the ear tag number matches the DNA you put inside the envelope. Failure to do so will result in a MISMATCHED DNA SAMPLE.
- Fill out the Packing Slip.
- Put the Packing Slip and a complete DNA Envelope for every goat listed on that Packing Slip in a secure envelope.
- **NO LATER THAN JULY 21st & ONLY BY USING CERTIFIED MAIL–RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED** mail the envelope to: Arkansas State Fair, Livestock Department, 2600 Howard Street Little Rock, AR 72206

MARKET LAMBS

2010 ARKANSAS STATE FAIR

SHOW DATE: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 9

MINIMUM WEIGHT: 90 / MAXIMUM WEIGHT: NONE

Market Lamb Ownership Deadline is **July 12, 2010**. Each exhibitor may nominate up to 6 lambs and is limited to 3 animals in the show or on the fairgrounds. All lambs must wear a Scrapie identification ear tag and an ASF Ear Tag. Exhibitor must submit a DNA sample and must be nominated online by the appropriate schedule and fees. Refer to the first page of this packet for details. All questions regarding animal health requirements should be directed to your local veterinarian or Arkansas Livestock & Poultry Commission at 501-907-2400 – Attention Dr. Pat Badley, AR State Veterinarian.

Either wethers or does may participate. The minimum weight for market lambs at the 2010 Arkansas State Fair is 90 pounds, no maximum. Exhibitors will declare show weights. A 5 pound tolerant weigh back is in place for the ASF Market Lamb Show and any lamb is subject to being weighed back. All lambs must have baby teeth at the show. No artificial coloring is allowed. Show classes will be divided by weight. All animals may be tested for various drugs and are subject to inspection at any time while on the fairgrounds. Registered ewes in the market show may also enter the breed show classes. Commercial ewes (two per exhibitor) in the market show may also enter the Commercial Ewe Show. Separate entry is required for both. Animals consigned to the Junior Livestock Auction are not eligible to participate in either; entry fees are not refundable. All rules listed in the 2010 ASF Livestock Premium Book Market Lamb section will apply to this show.

TO NOMINATE YOUR MARKET LAMB FOR THE STATE FAIR

- Ask your Vo-Ag Instructor or County Extension Agent to order an Animal ID Kit from the State Fair. The form to order this Kit is in this packet or online at www.asfg.net (Livestock). The Kit will cost \$22 if you order by July 5th. If you order between July 6th and July 12th the Kit will cost \$40. No orders will be accepted after July 12th.
- The State Fair will fill the order and return the ID Kit to your CEA or Vo-Ag Instructor. The kit will include an ASF ear tag for your lamb, a DNA envelope, instructions on how to pull DNA, and a Packing Slip for returning DNA to the State Fair Livestock Office.

- Fill out information on front of DNA Envelope completely and put accurate DNA sample inside envelope and seal the envelope. Make sure the ear tag number matches the DNA you put inside the envelope. Failure to do so will result in a MISMATCHED DNA SAMPLE.
- Fill out the Packing Slip.
- Put the Packing Slip and a complete DNA Envelope for every lamb listed on that Packing Slip in a secure envelope.

MARKET HOGS

2010 ARKANSAS STATE FAIR

SIFT DATE: WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 13

SHOW DATE: THURSDAY, OCTOBER 14

MINIMUM WEIGHT: 220 / MAXIMUM WEIGHT: 280

Market Hog Ownership Deadline is **July 12, 2010**. Each exhibitor may nominate up to 6 hogs and is limited to 2 Market Hogs in the Market Hog Sift/Show or on the fairgrounds. All hogs must wear a current ASF ear tag and exhibitor must submit a DNA sample and must be nominated online by the appropriate schedule and fees. Refer to the first page of this packet for details. All questions regarding animal health requirements should be directed to your local veterinarian or Arkansas Livestock & Poultry Commission at 501-907-2400 – Attention Dr. Pat Badley, AR State Veterinarian.

NEW for 2010 – All Commercial Gilts may arrive at Noon on Monday, October 11 and must be in place by 7 AM on Wednesday, October 13. All Commercial Gilts must participate in the sift and their weight will be declared by Exhibitor at the sift. Weight limit for Commercial Gilts is the same as for Market Hogs (220 – 280 pounds). A 5% weigh back will be in place at the Commercial Gilt Show. If a Commercial Gilt is disqualified in the sift, that animal is NOT eligible to compete in the Commercial Gilt Show or the Market Hog Show and the animal must be removed from the Fairgrounds immediately. Separate entry is required for Commercial Gilts and Market Hogs.

Registered Gilts are eligible to compete in the Market Hog Show and Breeding Classes, but must go through the sift to be eligible for competition in both. Registered Gilts competing in the Market Hog Show must meet weight guidelines (220 – 280 pounds). If a Registered Gilt is disqualified from the market show, she IS still eligible to compete in the Breeding Classes. Separate entry is required for Registered Gilts and Market Hogs.

- Ask your Vo-Ag Instructor or County Extension Agent to order an Animal ID Kit from the State Fair. The form to order this Kit is in this packet or online at www.asfg.net (Livestock). The Kit will cost \$22 if you order by July 12th. If you order between July 13th and July 20th the Kit will cost \$40. No orders will be accepted after July 20th.
- The State Fair will fill the order and return the ID Kit to your CEA or Vo-Ag Instructor. The kit will include an ASF ear tag for your hog, a DNA envelope, instructions on how to pull DNA, and a Packing Slip for returning DNA to the State Fair Livestock Office.
- When you receive the kit: put the tag in your hog's ear and pull DNA from hog.
- Fill out information on front of DNA Envelope completely and put accurate DNA sample inside envelope and seal the envelope. Make sure the ear tag number matches the DNA you put inside the envelope. Failure to do so will result in a MISMATCHED DNA SAMPLE.
- Fill out the Packing Slip.
- Put the Packing Slip and a complete DNA Envelope for every hog listed on that Packing Slip in a secure envelope.
- **NO LATER THAN JULY 27th & ONLY BY USING CERTIFIED MAIL–RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED** mail the envelope to: Arkansas State Fair, Livestock Department, 2600 Howard Street Little Rock, AR 72206
- THEN...Ask your CEA or Vo-Ag Instructor to nominate your hog online by going to www.asfg.net and clicking on Livestock. Then click on State Fair - 2010. From July 28th until August 11th Late Nomination costs \$20.
