SPECIAL RULES

ABGA rules shall govern the Open Boer Goat Show. All ASF General Rules and Regulations and Open Show specific rules for ASF apply to this show as well. Read all rules and regulations prior to arriving at show including PROHIBITED ACTS found in the General Rules and Regulations. All exhibitors are required to read and abide by the IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics.

This Show is ABGA sanctioned for Percentage Does, Full Blood/Purebred Does and Full Blood/Purebred Bucks. All Boer goats must be registered in the herd book of a recognized association 30 days prior to the opening date of the show. Recognized associations include ABGA, International Boer Goat Association, and the Canadian Boer Goat Association. The original registration certificate is required. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and must have been owned by the exhibitor 30 days prior to the opening date of the show. Animals must have registration numbers at time of entry. No pending registrations will be accepted. **COPIES OF PAPERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT CHECK IN!**

All animals are not to be moved from their assigned pen, stall or tie out space between the hours of 11 PM and 4 AM. Exhibitor access to animals during this time will be permitted. Animals are to be on display inside the Barns or in designated areas. Animals are not allowed to be housed inside livestock trailers except when being transported at appropriate time. At no time shall an animal enter a barn where different species are to be or are currently housed. For Example: Swine shall be limited to the swine barn and are not allowed in any other barn.

Percentage Boer Doe Classes are for does 50% to 87% Boer. Full-blood Boer Classes are 15/16 (93.7%) and higher for does and 31/32 (96.8%) and higher for bucks.

Animals shown in group classes must also be shown in individual classes.

Base date for figuring age is the date of the show.

All goats must exhibit well-healed tattoos and be correctly tattooed. Exhibitor is responsible for checking tattoos at time of application. Boer goats may have other means of permanent identification consistent with its registration certificate. If the animal has a microchip as its permanent identification, the exhibitor is responsible for providing a microchip reader.

Any Boer goat showing any pronounced defect or abnormality will be barred from all of the breeding classes. Artificial coloring will be a disqualification. Any Boer doe over 24 months of age that has not kidded and cannot prove a current pregnancy will not be allowed to show. These rules will be upheld by the Show Superintendents and Show Management. The decision will be final and not subject to protest.

An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased or possession taken within 90 days of the show.

Recognized associations include ABGA, International Boer Goat Association, and the Canadian Boer Goat Association. The original registration certificate is required. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and must have been owned by the exhibitor 30 days prior to the opening date of the show. Animals must have registration numbers at time of entry. No pending registrations will be accepted. **COPIES OF PAPERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT CHECK IN!**

Exhibitor access to animals during this time will be permitted. Animals are to be on display inside the Barns or in designated areas. At no time shall an animal enter a barn where different species are to be or are currently housed. For Example: Swine shall be limited to the swine barn and are not allowed in any other barn.

Percentage Boer Doe Classes are for does 50% to 87% Boer. Full-blood Boer Classes are 15/16 (93.7%) and higher for does and 31/32 (96.8%) and higher for bucks.

Animals shown in group classes must also be shown in individual classes.
