## SPECIAL RULES

ABGA rules shall govern the Junior Boer Goat Show. All ASF General Rules and Regulations and Junior Show specific rules for ASF apply to this show as well. Read all rules and regulations prior to arriving at show including PROHIBITED ACTS found in the General Rules and Regulations. All exhibitors are required to read and abide by the IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics.

All Junior Boer goats must be registered in the herd book of a recognized association according to the Junior Department Rules set by the Arkansas State Fair. Recognized associations include ABGA, International Boer Goat Association, and the Canadian Boer Goat Association. Animals must have registration numbers at time of entry. No copies of papers will be accepted at check in – original papers only. Goats must be registered in the Junior Exhibitor's name only no later than July 15. No co-ownerships, Chapter projects, Club projects, or partnerships are allowed.

Percentage Boer Doe Classes are for does 50% to 87% Boer. Full-blood Boer Classes are 15/16 (93.7%) and higher for does and 31/32 (96.8%) and higher for bucks.

All animals are not to be moved from their assigned pen, stall or tie out space between the hours of 11 PM and 4 AM. Exhibitor access to animals during this time will be permitted. Animals are to be on display inside the Barns, in designated grooming areas, in the show ring or at Tie-Outs when on the State Fairgrounds. Animals are not allowed to be housed inside livestock trailers except when being transported at appropriate time. At no time shall an animal enter a barn where different species are to be or are currently housed. For Example: Swine shall be limited to the swine barn and are not allowed in any other barn. No tents, covered, or enclosed areas are allowed at Tie-Outs.

Fitting, grooming and care of all junior livestock entries is to be performed solely by the exhibitor whose name appears on the entry. Exhibitors may be assisted only by their immediate family (which includes Parents, Permanent Legal Guardians when documentation of guardianship is provided to ASF, siblings, aunts, uncles, and grandparents); the exhibitor's County Extension Agent and/or FFA Instructor and fellow exhibitors who have an entry in the ASF Junior Livestock Show. The exhibitor must be present at all times during fitting when assistance is being provided. At no time shall an exhibitor provide payment in any form to anyone assisting in the grooming of an animal. Painting of switches, tail heads, topknots, and boning of legs are permissible.

Animals shown in group classes must also be shown in individual classes.

Base date for figuring age is the date of the show.

All goats must exhibit well-healed tattoos and be correctly tattooed. Exhibitors are responsible for checking tattoos at time of application. Boer goats may have other means of permanent identification consistent with its registration certificate. If the animal has a microchip as its permanent identification, the exhibitor is responsible for providing a microchip reader.

Any Boer goat showing any pronounced defect or abnormality will be barred from all of the breeding classes. Artificial coloring will be a disqualification. Any Boer doe over 24 months of age that has not kidded and cannot prove a current pregnancy will not be allowed to show. These rules will be upheld by the Show Superintendents and Show Management. The decision will be final and not subject to protest.

An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased or possession taken within 90 days of the show.

## JUNIOR BOER GOAT SHOWMANSHIP

Showmanship will be held at conclusion of the show and will be divided into two divisions:

Junior Showmanship: Ages 9 – 13

Senior Showmanship: 14 years and up
