Junior Commercial Heifer Showmanship will be at conclusion of Junior Commercial Heifer Show.

COMMERCIAL HEIFER: Any crossbred female or any percentage female not eligible for registration with any purebred breed association.

HEIFERS MUST HAVE ALL DECIDUOUS BABY TEETH AT TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW

COMMERCIAL HEIFERS entered in the 2010 Arkansas State Fair will be classified by the exhibitor in the following manner: EVERY Commercial Heifer shown must have a readable well-healed tattoo in her LEFT EAR. The exhibitor is 100% responsible for tattooing his or her heifer. Tattoos will be checked at processing.

Heifers should be tattooed according to classification as indicated below:

CLASSIFICATION OF HEIFER	TATTOO SHOULD READ
Exotic	SFX
American	SFA
English	SFE

Use the following Division & Class Numbers when completing entry information.

DIVISION 1200 / CLASS 1 – AMERICAN
DIVISION 1200 / CLASS 2 - ENGLISH
DIVISION 1200 / CLASS 3 - EXOTIC

Classes will be divided by hip height.

A Grand & Reserve Champion will be named in each Division in memory of Bill Dyer.

A Banner and Rosette will be awarded to Grand and Reserve Champions

No Supreme Commercial Heifer Champion will be named.

Tattoos will be checked during Commercial Heifer processing. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have a readable, well-healed tattoo in every Commercial Heifer's ear. Disqualification will be the immediate result of no tattoo. A well-healed tattoo is defined as a tattoo which indicates no raw puncture marks, scabs, blood, etc. The tattoo should be at least 30 days old in order to avoid the appearance of freshness. If there is any debate concerning a well-healed tattoo, the State Veterinarian will be called to make the final and absolute determination. Additional tattoos of Commercial Heifer entries will be cross-referenced with entries in purebred and composite shows. No animal is allowed to be shown in more than one show. Because the exhibitor will be allowed to classify his or her own heifer – the judge will be instructed to place the class with emphasis on breed character as well as overall quality. All General & Junior Rules of the ASF apply to this show.
