## SPECIAL RULES

All ASF General Rules and Regulations and Junior Show specific rules for ASF apply to this show as well. Read all rules and regulations prior to arriving at show including PROHIBITED ACTS found in the General Rules and Regulations. All exhibitors are required to read and abide by the IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics.

A Commercial Ewe is any ewe that is crossbred or any purebred ewe that is ineligible for registration. Ewes may be entered online at [www.asfg.net](http://www.asfg.net) or by paper entry form also available at this location. Exhibitors are limited to two entries in this show.

All animals are not to be moved from their assigned pen, stall or tie out space between the hours of 11 PM and 4 AM. Exhibitor access to animals during this time will be permitted. Animals are to be on display inside the Barns or in designated areas. Animals are not allowed to be housed inside livestock trailers except when being transported at appropriate time. At no time shall an animal enter a barn where different species are to be or are currently housed. For Example: Swine shall be limited to the swine barn and are not allowed in any other barn.

Fitting, grooming and care of all junior livestock entries is to be performed solely by the exhibitor whose name appears on the entry. Exhibitors may be assisted only by their immediate family (which includes Parents, Permanent Legal Guardians when documentation of guardianship is provided to ASF, siblings, aunts, uncles, and grandparents); the exhibitor's County Extension Agent and/or FFA Instructor and fellow exhibitors who have an entry in the ASF Junior Livestock Show. The exhibitor must be present at all times during fitting when assistance is being provided. At no time shall an exhibitor provide payment in any form to anyone assisting in the grooming of an animal.

Exhibitors will declare show weight of Commercial Ewes. Minimum weight is 90 pounds and there is no maximum weight. These animals may be subject to a 5 pound weigh back on show day. Weight cards must be turned in to the Show Superintendent no later than 10 AM on Friday, October 8. Ewes must be processed with Market Lambs and must be checked for wool fungus, ringworm, and any communicable diseases. Commercial Ewes must have a full mouth of baby teeth, no permanent teeth showing and must meet all health regulations mandated by Arkansas Livestock & Poultry.

Classes will be divided by weight without regard to breed. The number of entries will determine the number of classes. Division Method may be used depending on numbers to be shown.

Ewes shown in the Market Lamb Show are also eligible for the Commercial Ewe Show. However, ewes selected for Auction shall be ineligible to show in the Commercial Ewe Show.

### COMMERCIAL EWE SHOWMANSHIP

Showmanship classes will be divided as follows:

**JUNIOR — Ages 9-13      SENIOR — Ages 14 and up**

*Age division will be determined by the age of the exhibitor on the opening day of the State Fair (October 8, 2010). Showman must show his own animal in Showmanship.*

*Showmanship will be judged at the end of the Commercial Ewe Show.*

*Ribbons will be awarded through 5th place.*

Exhibitors must register for Showmanship and wear an ASF issued back number to participate. This is a Breeding Sheep Showmanship competition.
