### SPECIAL RULES

**NEW RULE** – Registered Gilts are eligible to compete in the Market Hog Show and Breeding Show, but in order to compete in the Market Hog Show, the registered animal must go through the sift. Registered Gilts competing in Market Hog Show must meet weight guidelines (220 to 280 pounds). If a registered Gilt is disqualified from the Market Hog Show – she is still eligible to compete in the breeding classes. Separate entry is required for registered gilts and market hogs. Registered hogs may arrive on Fairgrounds at Noon on Monday, October 11 if they will compete in the Market Hog Show or Swine Showmanship.

A breed must have a minimum of ten animals shown by at least two exhibitors to have their own Breed Show. Any breed not meeting these criteria may be moved to the AOB Show.

An exhibitor may enter no more than two animals in each class.

All Junior Exhibitors will pay one entry fee which automatically enters them into the Open & Junior Breeding Swine Shows.

Judging of the breeds in the Open and Junior divisions will be on a rotating basis each year. The 2010 show order will be as follows: Yorkshire, AOB, Berkshire, Chester White, Duroc, Hampshire, Landrace, Poland China, and Spotted Swine. Breeds not entering ten (10) head by two (2) exhibitors may be dropped from the show order and will be placed in the AOB class. Open and Junior Classes will be judged at the same time.

Landrace Swine exhibited at state and national shows may not exhibit excessive skin pigmentation or any hair color. Excessive is defined as over three spots, any one of which is greater than the size of a quarter. **All exhibitors are responsible for making sure their animals meet the breed color marking requirements for exhibition. All animals not meeting the breeds marking requirement for exhibition will be disqualified and will NOT receive a refund of entry fees.**

Registration papers are required and will be inspected by a Swine Superintendent at Check-in (Friday, October 15 from 10 AM until 1 PM) for proof of ownership and age of the animals entered. Bring online entry receipt or copy of entry form for proof of entry and clarification of entry issues.

All animals shown must exhibit well-healed litter marks.

Pigs farrowed after April 30, 2010 cannot compete.

All animals must be registered in the name of the junior exhibitor only with an ownership date of July 15 or prior. Animals registered in the name of a partnership, FFA Chapter or 4-H Club entries can only be shown in Open Swine Show.
