**COMMERCIAL HEIFER: Any crossbred female or any percentage female not eligible for registration with any purebred breed association.**

All Commercial Heifers must have a readable, well-healed tattoo in **BOTH EARS**. The exhibitor is 100% responsible for tattooing the heifer. No Horned Heifers or Heifers with scurs will be eligible to participate.

Heifers should be tattooed according to classification as indicated below:

<b>CLASSIFICATION OF HEIFER</b>	<b>TATTOO SHOULD READ</b>
Exotic	SFX
American	SFA
English	SFE

Use the following Division & Class Numbers when completing entry information.

**DIVISION 1201 / CLASS 1 – AMERICAN**

**DIVISION 1202 / CLASS 2 - ENGLISH**

**DIVISION 1203 / CLASS 3 - EXOTIC**

**Classes will be divided by weight.**

A Grand & Reserve Champion will be named in each Division in memory of Bill Dyer.

A Banner will be awarded to Grand and Reserve Champions

A Supreme Commercial Heifer Champion will be named.

Tattoos will be checked during Commercial Heifer processing. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have a readable, well-healed tattoo in every Commercial Heifer's ear. Disqualification will be the immediate result of no tattoo. A well-healed tattoo is defined as a tattoo which indicates no raw puncture marks, scabs, blood, etc. The tattoo should be at least 30 days old in order to avoid the appearance of freshness. If there is any debate concerning a well-healed tattoo, the State Veterinarian will be called to make the final and absolute determination. Additional tattoos of Commercial Heifer entries will be cross-referenced with entries in purebred and composite shows. No animal is allowed to be shown in more than one show. Because the exhibitor will be allowed to classify his or her own heifer – the judge will be instructed to place

the class with emphasis on breed character as well as overall quality. All General & Junior Rules of the ASF apply to this show.
