24	Dairy Herd; group consists of four cows that have freshened, all are to be owned by exhibitor. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry	Banner
25	Best Three Females, any age; all are to have been bred and owned by exhibitor. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry	Banner
26	Daughter-Dam; A cow and one offspring of any age. Animals may be owned by one or more exhibitor. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry from each Dam.	Banner
27	Produce of Dam; Group to consist of two animals, any age, the produce of one cow. The dam must be named. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry from the same cow. Animals need not both be owned by one exhibitor.	Banner
28	Exhibitor's Herd; Three cows that have calved and two heifers any age.	Banner
29	Get-of-Sire; Four animals by one sire shown in the classes listed above.	Banner
30	Premier Exhibitor; The exhibitor winning the most points on – not to exceed eight animals owned and exhibited in the open show single classes.	Banner
31	Premier Breeder; The breeder winning the most points on – not to exceed eight animals in the open single classes, exhibited by one or multiple exhibitors.	Banner
32	Best Udder	Banner
